

BY-LAW No. 864 ✓

of the Rural Municipality of Morris relative to the closing and opening of a road through the West half of 8-6-1E

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to close that portion of a public road shewn on a plan of survey registered in the Winnipeg Land Titles Office as No. 1534 colored green on a plan sworn by Charles D. Brown, M.L.S. on the 5th day of July, 1955 and to open as a public road all that portion thereof colored pink on said plan of survey sworn by Charles D. Brown, M.L.S. on the 5th day of July, 1955.

AND WHEREAS under the provisions of Section 474 of The Municipal Act, being Cap. 173 R.S.M. 1954 and amendments thereto, every Municipal Corporation may pass by-laws for the closing, opening and establishing and maintaining public roads within its confines.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Rural Municipality of Morris enacts as follows:

1. THAT that portion of the public road shewn on a Plan of Survey registered in the Winnipeg Land Titles Office as No. 1534 which is now shewn colored green on a plan of survey sworn by Charles Dudley Brown, M.L.S. on the 5th day of July, 1955, be and is hereby closed as a public road.

2. THAT all that portion of the West half of Section Eight (8) in Township Six (6) and Range One (1) East of the Principal Meridian in Manitoba, shewn colored pink in a Plan of Survey sworn by Charles Dudley Brown, M.L.S. on the 5th day of July, 1955 be and is hereby opened as a public road.

3. THAT that portion of the road now closed and shewn colored green on the said plan sworn by the said Charles Dudley Brown be vested in and belong to the proprietors of the land from which the old highway was originally taken.

DONE AND PASSED by the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris, assembled at Morris, in the Province of Manitoba, this 10 day of July A. D. 1959.
