

BY - LAW No. 865

Being a By-Law of the Rural Municipality of Morris for the purpose of exempting the "Legion Hall" at Sperling, Man., from taxation.

WHEREAS the "Legion Hall", owned by the Sperling Branch of the Canadian Legion, is used mainly for the benefit of the community, as well as for the purposes of the Legion,

AND WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to exempt the taxes on said Hall for a period of five years, commencing January 1, A.D. 1959;

NOW THEREFORE pursuant to Section 984(1) of The Municipal Act, be it enacted and it is hereby enacted, that the aforesaid Hall be and is hereby exempted from any Municipal Taxation, for a period of FIVE YEARS, commencing January 1, 1959.
