

BY-LAW No. 866
of the Rural Municipality of Morris.

WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Morris is the owner of the most southerly Two Hundred and Eight (208) feet in width of the most westerly Two Hundred and Eight feet in depth of the South-west Quarter of Section Twelve (12) in Township Six (6) and Range Two (2) West of the Principal Meridian in Manitoba, the said property having been acquired by tax sale;

AND WHEREAS the Mennonite Brethren Church of Manitoba have offered to purchase the said property for the sum of Twenty (\$20.00) dollars, and it is deemed advisable to sell the said property;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted and it is hereby enacted as By-Law No. 866 of the Rural Municipality of Morris that the said property be sold to the Mennonite Brethren Church of Manitoba and the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer be authorized to sign and seal the necessary conveyance.

DONE AND PASSED at a meeting of the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held at the Town of Morris on the 11 day of September, A.D. 1959.
