By-Law No. 867

WHEREAS, Sec. 1188 of "The Municipal Act" provides for the cancellation of taxes or any debts owing the municipality:

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris considers it is in the best interests of the municipality to cancel the herein-after mentioned taxes, hospital accounts and accounts receivable;
