

BY-LAW No. 884 <sup>164</sup>

of the Rural Municipality of Morris authorizing the sale of the following described land:

"The most Northerly Two Hundred and six and one-half feet in depth of the most Southerly Four Hundred and thirteen feet in depth of the most Westerly Two Hundred and fifty feet in width of the most Easterly Four Hundred and fifty feet in width of the South-East quarter of Section Ten in the Sixth Township and First Range, East of the Principal Meridian in Manitoba. Subject to the reservations in favour of the Crown set forth in the Crown Lands Act and the Water Rights Act."

to John Goossen of the Post Office of McTavish in Manitoba, Farmer.

WHEREAS the above described lands have been vested in the Rural Municipality of Morris pursuant to tax sale;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 1182 of the Municipal Act, R.S.M. 1954 and amendments thereto a municipality may sell and convey land acquired pursuant to tax sales on such terms as it sees fit;

AND WHEREAS The Rural Municipality in the execution of drainage work damaged the property belonging to John Goossen of the Post Office of McTavish in Manitoba, Farmer;

AND WHEREAS John Goossen of the Post Office of McTavish in the Province of Manitoba has offered to purchase the above described land at and for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED and it is hereby enacted as By-law No. 884 of the Rural Municipality of Morris that the following described lands, namely:

"the most Northerly Two Hundred and six and one-half feet in depth of the most Southerly Four Hundred and thirteen feet in depth of the most Westerly Two Hundred and fifty feet in width of the most Easterly Four Hundred and fifty feet in width of the South-East quarter of Section Ten in the Sixth Township and First Range, East of the Principal Meridian in Manitoba, Subject to the reservations in favour of the Crown set forth in the Crown Lands Act and the Water Rights Act.",

be and are hereby sold to John Goossen of the Post Office of McTavish in the Province of Manitoba, farmer, in consideration of the damage done to his property and the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar.
