

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

BY-LAW NO. 885

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 515 (1)(a) of The Municipal Act being Cap 173, R. S. M. 1954 and Amendments thereto, any Municipality may pass by-laws for constructing, opening, making, improving, deepening, contracting, widening, altering, diverting, straightening, discontinuing, or stopping up any drain or natural watercourse or surface watercourse within the jurisdiction of the municipality, or providing outlets therefor or preventing surface water flooding into or within the municipality and for entering upon, breaking up, acquiring, taking or using any land in or adjacent to the municipality in any way necessary or desirable, in the opinion of the council, for any such purpose;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 396 (1)(a) of The Municipal Act being Cap 173, R. S. M. 1954 and Amendments thereto, whereby any Municipal Corporation may pass by-laws for acquiring such real and personal property as is required for the use of the corporation, and for erecting, improving, and maintaining halls and other houses and buildings required by, and being upon the lands of, the corporation, and for disposing of or leasing such property when no longer required on such terms as it sees fit;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to construct a drain on the following described lands, namely:

All those portions of River Lots 493, 495, 497, 499, 501, 503, 505, 507, 509, 511, as shewn coloured blue on a Plan of Survey of land required for Public Drain across river lots 493 to 511, (odd numbers) of the Parish of Ste. Agathe, made by Andrew Taylor, M. L. S. and sworn on the 19th day of December, A. D. 1960.

AND WHEREAS the owners of the lands across whose lands said drain will be constructed have agreed to accept a consideration of \$70.00 per acre for same.

AND WHEREAS the consideration is deemed fair and reasonable.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. THAT the Municipality of Morris construct a drain across the following described lands, namely:

All those portions of River Lots 493, ~~495~~, ~~497~~, ~~499~~, 501, 503, 505, 507, 509, 511, as shewn coloured blue on a Plan of Survey of land required for Public Drain across river lots 493 to 511, (odd numbers), of the Parish of Ste. Agathe, made by Andrew Taylor, M. L. S. and sworn on the 19th day of December, A. D. 1960.

2. THAT the Municipality of Morris pay to the registered owners of the above described lands the sum of \$70.00 per acre for all the land used in construction of the said drain.
3. THAT the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer be and are hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to complete the construction of this drain.

DONE AND PASSED by the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris, assembled at Morris, in the Province of Manitoba, this 14th day of July, A. D. 1961.
