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BY-LAW No. 890
of the Rural Municipality of Morris

WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Morris purchased from Robert Russell, land to be used for the erection of a machine shed and obtained Certificate of Title No. 779709 covering the following property:

"All those portions of River Lots Three hundred and thirty-seven and Three hundred and thirty-nine of the Parish of Sainte Agathe, in Manitoba, which lots are shewn on a plan of Special Survey registered in the Winnipeg Land Titles Office as No. 3799 and bounded as follows: On the South by the Southern limit of said River Lot Three hundred and thirty-seven on the North by a straight line drawn North of parallel with and perpendicularly distant nine hundred and forty-seven feet from said Southern limit and on the East and West by two straight lines drawn Northerly at right angles to said Southern limit from points in said Southern limit distant Westerly thereon five hundred and sixty feet and seven hundred and sixty feet respectively from the Western limit of the land taken for the right-of-way of the Canadian Pacific Railway as same is shewn on a plan filed in the said Office as No. 374."

AND WHEREAS it appears that an error was made by the surveyor in connection with the said property and it is deemed desirable to correct the said error.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted as follows:

1. THAT the Rural Municipality of Morris convey to Lawrence Gruenke of the Municipality of Morris, in Manitoba, farmer, the land above described in exchange for a transfer from the said Lawrence Gruenke of the following property:

"All those portions of River Lots Three Hundred and Thirty-seven and Three Hundred and Thirty-nine of the Parish of Saint Agathe, in Manitoba, according to a plan of same registered in the Winnipeg Land Titles Office as No. 3799, bounded as follows: On the South by the Southern limit of said River Lot Three Hundred and Thirty-seven, on the North by a straight line drawn North of, parallel with and perpendicularly distant Nine Hundred and Forty-seven feet from said Southern limit and on the East and West by two straight lines drawn Northerly at right angles to said Southern limit from points in the same distant Westerly thereon Five Hundred and Sixty-five feet and Seven Hundred and Sixty-five feet respectively from the Western limit of the land taken for the right of way of the Canadian Pacific Railway as same is shewn on a plan filed in the said Office as No. 374."
