

BY-LAW NO. 891 JH7.

BEING a by-law of the Rural Municipality of Morris relative to the purchasing of property for the purposes of a fire hall.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 396 (1) (a) of The Municipal Act being Chapter 173 of the Revised Statutes of Manitoba, 1954 and amendments thereto, 396. (1) Every municipal corporation may pass by-laws

(a) for acquiring such real and personal property as is required for the use of the corporation, and for erecting, improving, and maintaining halls and other houses and buildings required by, and being upon the lands of, the corporation, and for disposing of or leasing such property when no longer required on such terms as it sees fit;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 401 (1) (a) of the said Act, 401. (1) Any municipal corporation may pass by-laws

(a) for entering upon, taking or using land in any way necessary or convenient for the purposes of a fire hall;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and desirable to construct a firehall on the property hereinafter referred to.

AND WHEREAS Abram Penner Goossen, of the Municipality of Morris, in Manitoba, Manager, has offered to sell to the Rural Municipality of Morris the following described land, namely:

"All that portion of the North-west Quarter of Section Five (5) in the Sixth Township and First Range East of the Principal Meridian in Manitoba, described as follows: Commencing at a point on the Northern boundary of the said quarter section distant Westerly thereon One Hundred (100) feet from the North West corner of Lot Two (2) which lot is shewn on a plan of survey registered in the Winnipeg Land Titles Office as No. 5176; thence Westerly along the Northern boundary of said quarter section a distance of thirty (30) feet; thence Southerly and parallel to the Western boundary of said lot two a distance of eighty (80) feet; thence Easterly and parallel to the Northern boundary of said quarter section a distance of Thirty (30) feet; thence Northerly and parallel to the Western boundary of said Lot two, to the point of commencement."

at and for the sum of Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars.

AND WHEREAS the consideration is deemed fair and reasonable.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED and it is hereby enacted as by-law No. 891 of the Rural Municipality of Morris,

1. THAT the Rural Municipality of Morris purchase from Abram Penner Goossen, of the Municipality of Morris, in Manitoba, Manager, the following described property, namely:

"All that portion of the North West Quarter of Section Five (5) in the Sixth Township and First Range East of the Principal Meridian in Manitoba, described as follows: Commencing at a point on the Northern boundary of the said quarter section distant Westerly thereon One Hundred (100) feet from the North-west Corner of Lot Two (2) which lot is shewn on a plan of survey registered in the Winnipeg Land Titles Office as No. 5176; thence Westerly along the Northern boundary of said quarter section a distance of thirty (30) feet; thence Southerly and parallel to the Western boundary of said Lot Two a distance of eighty (80) feet; thence Easterly and parallel to the Northern boundary of said quarter section a distance of Thirty (30) feet; thence Northerly and parallel to the Western boundary of said Lot Two; to the point of commencement."

at and for the sum of Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars for the purposes of constructing thereon a firehall.

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Morris.

2. THAT the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer by and are hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to completed the said transaction.
