WHEREAS the above described lands have been vested in the Rural Municipality of Morris pursuant to tax sale;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 1182 of the Municipal Act, R.S.M. 1954 and amendments thereto a municipality may sell and convey land acquired pursuant to tax sales on such terms as it sees fit;

AND WHEREAS David Penner, of the Post Office of Lowe Farm, in Manitoba, Labourer, has offered to purchase the above described land at and for the sum of One hundred (\$100.00) Dollars.

AND WHEREAS the consideration is deemed fair and reasonable.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED, and it is hereby enacted as By-Law No. 905 of the Rural Municipality of Morris that the following described lands, namely:
