

BY-LAW NO. 910

of the Rural Municipality of Morris, authorizing the sale of the following described land:

all that portion of the North-East quarter of Section Thirty, in Township Six and Range Two, West of the Principal Meridian, in the Province of Manitoba, described as follows: the most Easterly One Hundred and Twenty Feet of said quarter Section which lies between two lines drawn at right angles to the Eastern Limit of said quarter Section from points distant Northerly thereon Three Hundred feet and Four Hundred and Thirty feet respectively from its intersection with the Northern Limit of the land taken for the Right-of-way of the Canadian Northern Railway as shewn on a plan of survey filed in the Carman Land Titles Office as No. 750. Subject to Special Reservations as to Mines, Minerals and other matters as particularly defined in Cap 52 S.M. 1949.

WHEREAS the above described lands have been vested in the Rural Municipality of Morris pursuant to tax sale;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 1182 of the Municipal Act, R.S.M. 1954 and amendments thereto a Municipality may sell and convey land acquired pursuant to tax sales on such terms as it sees fit;

AND WHEREAS Robert Earl Brown, of the Post Office of Sperling in Manitoba, Farmer, has offered to purchase the above described land at and for the sum of Fifty Dollars. (\$50.00).

AND WHEREAS the consideration is deemed fair and reasonable.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED, and it is hereby enacted as By-Law No. 910 of the Rural Municipality of Morris that the following described lands, namely:
