

BY-LAW No. 919

The Rural Municipality of Morris

By-Law No. 919 being a By-Law of The Rural Municipality of Morris for the purpose of transferring certain lands from the Steinfeld School District No. 1128 to the Lowe Farm Consolidated School District No. 2377; and also transferring certain lands from the Lowe Farm Consolidated School District No. 2377 to the Steinfeld School District No. 1128. (Sec. 7(1) (d) Public Schools Act).

WHEREAS, a petition has been presented to the Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris requesting the transfer of the following lands:

- (1) The South-east quarter of Section 20-4-1 WPM, owned by Mrs. Mary Giesbrecht, from the Steinfeld S.D. No. 1128 to the Lowe Farm Consolidated S. D. No. 2377;

and

- (2) The South-east quarter of Section 9-4-1 WPM owned by William H. Funk, from the Lowe Farm Consolidated School District No. 2377, to the Steinfeld S.D. No. 1128;

AND WHEREAS the owners of the lands affected have indicated their approval of said transfer by affixing their signatures to the petition;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris, in open session assembled, enacts as follows:

THAT the South-east quarter of Section 20-4-1 WPM be transferred from the School District of Steinfeld No. 1128 and added to the Lowe Farm Consolidated School District No. 2377, and that the land so added shall assume its just portion of the debenture debt of the Lowe Farm Consolidated School District No. 2377;

and

THAT the South-east quarter of Section 9-4-1 WPM be transferred from the Lowe Farm Consolidated School District No. 2377 and added to the Steinfeld School District No. 1128 and be relieved of all responsibility of the Lowe Farm Consolidated S.D. #2377.

THAT this By-Law supercedes any previous By-Laws as to the boundaries of the said Steinfeld and Lowe Farm Consolidated School Districts.

READ the first and second time in open Council assembled, this 14th day of February, A.D. 1964.
