

BY-LAW No. 920

The Rural Municipality of Morris

By-Law No. 920 being a By-Law of The Rural Municipality of Morris for the purpose of transferring certain lands from the Kronsweide School District No. 1030 to the Lowe Farm Consolidated School District No. 2377; and also transferring certain lands from the Lowe Farm Consolidated School District No. 2377 to the Kronsweide School District #1030. (Sec. 7(1)(d) Public Schools Act)

WHEREAS, a petition has been presented to the Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris requesting the transfer of the following lands:

- (1) The North-east quarter of Section 19-4-1 WPM, owned by D. H. Froese, from the School District of Kronsweide No. 1030, to the Lowe Farm Consolidated School District No. 2377;

and

- (2) The South-west quarter of Section 36-4-2 WPM, owned by B. N. Wall, from the Lowe Farm Consolidated School District No. 2377, to the Kronsweide School District No. 1030;

AND WHEREAS the owners of the lands affected have indicated their approval of said transfer by affixing their signatures to the petition;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris, in an open session assembled, enacts as follows:

THAT the North-east quarter of Section 19-4-1 WPM be transferred from the School District of Kronsweide No. 1030 and added to the Lowe Farm Consolidated School District No. 2377, and that the land so added shall assume its just proportion of the debenture debt of the Lowe Farm Consolidated School District No. 2377;

and

THAT the South-west quarter of Section 36-4-2 WPM be transferred from the Lowe Farm Consolidated School District No. 2377 and added to the Kronsweide School District No. 1030, and be relieved of all responsibility of the Lowe Farm Consolidated School District #2377. THAT this By-Law supercedes any previous By-Laws as to the boundaries of the said Kronsweide and Lowe Farm Consolidated School Districts.

READ the first and second time in open Council assembled, this 14th day of February, A.D. 1964.
