

BY-LAW NO. 921

of the Rural Municipality of Morris, authorizing the sale of the following described land:

"Being Lots Nine (9) and Ten (10) in Block Four (4) as shown on a plan of survey of a part of the Village of Lowe Farm, in the Province of Manitoba, excepting thereout the most Northerly Sixty (60) feet in depth thereof, registered in the Morden Land Titles Office as No. 522."

to Frank Martens, of the Village of Lowe Farm, in the Province of Manitoba, Mechanic.

WHEREAS the above described lands have been vested in the Rural Municipality of Morris pursuant to tax sale;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 1182 of the Municipal Act, R.S.M. 1954, and amendments thereto a Municipality may sell and convey land acquired pursuant to tax sales on such terms as it sees fit;

AND WHEREAS Frank Martens, of the Village of Lowe Farm, in the Province of Manitoba, Mechanic, has offered to purchase the above described land at and for the sum of Eighty-Five Dollars. (\$85.00).

AND WHEREAS the consideration is deemed fair and reasonable.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED, and it is hereby enacted as By-Law No. 921 of the Rural Municipality of Morris in Council duly assembled

(1) THAT the following described lands, namely: Being Lots Nine (9) and Ten (10) in Block Four (4) as shown on a plan of survey of a part of the Village of Lowe Farm, in the Province of Manitoba, excepting thereout the most Northerly Sixty (60) feet in depth thereof, registered in the Morden Land Titles Office as No. 522

be sold to Frank Martens, of the Village of Lowe Farm, in the Province of Manitoba, Mechanic, at and for the sum of (\$85.00) Eighty-Five Dollars.

(2) THAT the Reeve and Secretary Treasurer be and are hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to complete the above transaction.
