

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

BY-LAW NO. 933

A By-Law to authorize the submission of By-Law No. 932 of the Rural Municipality of Morris to the ratepayers of the said Municipality having property situated in Township Six and Range Two, West of the Principal Meridian, in Manitoba, and qualified to vote thereon pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Act, R. S. M. 1954 and amendments thereto, and The Elderly and Infirm Persons Housing Act, S. M. 1964 (first session) Cap. 17

WHEREAS By-Law No. 932 being a By-Law of the Rural Municipality of Morris to authorize the said Municipality to borrow the sum of Four thousand, Two Hundred and Forty Eight (\$4,248.00) Dollars by the issue and sale of debentures to assist in the construction of a building to provide housing accommodation for elderly and infirm persons has received its first and second readings by the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris.

AND WHEREAS in paragraph six of the said By-Law it is provided that the whole of the said indebtedness shall be raised annually by a special rate on all that portion of the Rural Municipality of Morris described as follows:

Township Six (6), and Range Two (2), West  
of the Principal Meridian, in Manitoba.

AND WHEREAS it is the opinion of all members of the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris that the said By-Law benefits only that portion of the Municipality hereinbefore described as rateable under the said By-Law.

NOW THEREFORE the Rural Municipality of Morris in Council duly assembled enacts as follows:

1. That By-law No. 932 of the Rural Municipality of Morris be submitted to a vote of the ratepayers qualified to vote thereon pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Act, R. S. M. 1954 and amendments thereto and of the Elderly and Infirm Persons Housing Act, S. M. 1964 (first session) Cap. 17, in all that portion of the Municipality of Morris described as follows:  
Township Six (6), and Range Two (2), West  
of the Principal Meridian, in Manitoba.
2. That the said By-law shall be submitted to the ratepayers as hereinbefore provided without requiring any petition to be presented by any resident ratepayers whatsoever, and without any deposit being required to be paid to the Treasurer of the Municipality.
3. That the voting shall take place on Tuesday, the twenty-seventh day of July, A.D. 1965, between the hours of nine o'clock in the forenoon and six o'clock in the afternoon at the


4. That the Clerk of the Municipality shall cause to be published a notice of the said vote on one issue of the Manitoba Gazette and three issues of the Dufferin Leader, and shall cause signs to be posted advertising the said vote, in the manner set out in The Municipal Act, and amendments thereto.


5. That on the twenty-sixth day of July, A.D. 1965 at the hour of two o'clock in the afternoon, the Reeve shall attend at the Office of the Municipality of Morris for the purpose of appointing persons to attend at the polling place and at the final summing up of the votes, on behalf of persons interested in and desirous of promoting or opposing the passage of the said By-law.


6. That on the twenty-eighth day of July, A.D. 1965 at ten o'clock in the forenoon at the said Municipal Office, the Clerk of the said Municipality shall sum up the number of votes given for and against the said By-law.


7. That the Clerk of the Rural Municipality of Morris shall be and hereby is appointed Returning Officer for and during the voting of the said By-law.
