

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

By-Law No. 937

Being a By-Law for the purpose of fixing the time and place of meetings of the Council and the indemnity for same, in 1966.

Sec. 309

WHEREAS it is necessary to fix the time and place of meetings of the Council and the indemnity for same;

NOW THEREFORE the Council in session assembled, enacts as follows:

THAT the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris shall hold its regular monthly meetings in the Court House Building in the Town of Morris, Manitoba, on the SECOND FRIDAY of each month, at 10 o'clock in the forenoon, during the Year 1966..

THAT, should it be deemed expedient to hold a SPECIAL MEETING, the Reeve and two members of the Council may convene same by giving before the day of the meeting, a reasonable notice of such a meeting to all members of the Council. Each notice of a special meeting shall contain the subject matter of the meeting.

THAT, should it be deemed expedient at any regular meeting of the Council to change the date of the next regular meeting to another date than set by By-Law, the Council may make such change by resolution, if said resolution carries by a majority of the members present.

THAT, the Reeve and Councillors be paid \$1,50 per hour and 10¢ per mile for inspection or other services rendered on behalf of the municipality, providing that such accounts are verified by statutory declaration and filed with the clerk.

THAT the indemnity for attending meetings in one year shall not exceed \$600.00 in case of a Councillor and not exceed \$1,200.00 in the case of a Reeve and each be paid 10 cents per mile travelling to and from meetings.

THAT, should the Reeve and Councillors necessarily go outside the Municipality on business for the corporation, they shall be entitled to receive their actual expenses in connection with same.
