Being a By-Law of The Rural Municipality of Morris relative to the purchase of certain equipment.

WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Morris deems it advisable to purchase certain equipment to better carry out its road and drainage construction program;

AND WHEREAS Powell Equipment Co. Ltd. of Winnipeg has offered to sell to the municipality the following equipment:

One Caterpillar D7E Tractor, power shift, model ARR 1 M 4514-78" gauge, includes gasoline starting engine with 12 Volt electric starter, 6 roller track frame, rigid drawbar, hydraulic track assembly and 22" growser tracks (38 sect.) reversible fan, crank case guard, track guiding guards, front pull hook, lighting system 4 lights,

One hydraulic Angling dozer, cutting edge and end bits, 173 hydr. control, series B, single valve

One used 435 Scraper - capacity 15 to 19 yds,


for the sum of Sixty thousand, five hundred dollars (\$60,500.00)

AND WHEREAS the price is considered fair and reasonable,


