

BY-LAW NO. 951

OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

Being a By-Law for the opening of a highway over and across part of the East Half of Section Seven (7) in Township Six (6) and Range One (1) East of the Principal Meridian in Manitoba.

WHEREAS Section 474 of The Municipal Act authorizes and empowers a municipal corporation to pass by-laws for opening, establishing and maintaining highways;

AND WHEREAS Council deems it expedient that a highway named Brandt Street and shown outlined in pink on a plan prepared by Joseph Henry Wilson, M.L.S., and duly attested by him on the 25th day of November, A.D. 1966, be opened, established and maintained;

AND WHEREAS the owners of all the land required to be taken for the purposes of establishing and opening the said highway have consented in writing to the passage of this By-law and to the acquisition of the said land by the Municipality;

BE IT THEREFORE PASSED AND ENACTED as a By-law of The Rural Municipality of Morris as follows:

1. The lands shown as Brandt Street and outlined in pink on the said plan and prepared by Joseph Henry Wilson, M.L.S., and duly attested by him on the 25th day of November, A.D. 1966, which plan is hereby adopted and approved, are hereby expropriated, and the officers, employees and agents of the Municipality are authorized and empowered to enter in and upon such lands and to break up the same for highway purposes.
2. The said lands shown as Brandt Street and outlined in pink on the aforementioned plan are hereby opened up and established as a public roadway and dedicated for such purpose.
3. The Secretary-Treasurer is directed to endorse the aforementioned plan for identification, affixing his signature under the corporate seal of the Municipality, together with a reference to this By-law.




