

BY-LAW NO. 954

of the Rural Municipality of Morris.

Being a By-law relative to the entering into of an Agreement with reference to the demolition of the office building of the Rural Municipality of Morris.

WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Morris has undertaken to construct a new office building;

AND WHEREAS in order to proceed with said construction the present office building will have to be demolished;

AND WHEREAS Jacob Reimer and Henry Reimer, both of the Post Office of Homewood, in Manitoba, have offered to demolish the said office building of the Rural Municipality of Morris;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE/IT ENACTED, and it is hereby enacted as By-law No. 954 of the Rural Municipality of Morris:

1. THAT the Rural Municipality of Morris enter into an Agreement with Jacob Reimer and Henry Reimer, both of the Post Office of Homewood, in Manitoba, to demolish the office building of the Rural Municipality of Morris.
2. THAT the price to be paid to Jacob Reimer and Henry Reimer for the demolition of the office building be the sum of Two Thousand, Two Hundred (\$2,200.00) Dollars.
3. THAT the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer be, and are hereby authorized to do all things necessary to give force and effect to this By-law.
