

BY-LAW No. 956

being a By-Law of The Rural Municipality of Morris to merge the Kronsweide School District No. 1030 with the Lowe Farm Consolidated School District No. 2377.

WHEREAS, under Section 7(1)(g) of The Public Schools Act, the council of a rural municipality on its own initiative, or on the petition of any four electors of the territory effected, may, by by-law, unite two or more districts in the same municipality into one, if a majority in number of the resident electors of each such district present at any annual or special meeting pass resolutions requesting the council to pass such by-law;

AND WHEREAS a special meeting has been held by the Kronsweide S.D. at which a large majority of the ratepayers attending voted in favor of consolidating with the Lowe Farm Consolidated School District #2377

AND WHEREAS The Board of Trustees of the Lowe Farm Cons. S.D. #2377, by petition, endorsed the above request,

AND WHEREAS due notice in writing, setting out the time and place at which the matter would be dealt with, was mailed to the last known address of the Secretary-Treasurer of every school district and of the school division concerned, and every rate-payer whose land would be effected by the proposed action;

AND WHEREAS all interested parties present and wishing to be heard were given an opportunity to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris in council assembled enacts as follows:


THAT the School District of Kronsweide #1030 be dissolved and united ~~into~~ into one school district to be known as the Consolidated S.D. of Lowe Farm #2377;

THAT the assets of each school district hereby merged be vested in the Consolidated S.D. of Lowe Farm #2377 and be used to meet the operational and capital expenditures of the said School District;

THAT all the debts and liabilities, including debenture debt, of each district hereby merged be assumed by the Consolidated School District of Lowe Farm #2377 and be chargeable on, and levied against, the lands comprised in the said school district;


THAT this By-Law shall come into effect as of, on, and from the first day of January, A.D. 1968.
