

BY-LAW NO. 971

Being a by-law of The Rural Municipality of Morris relative to the construction of offices in the lower level of the Municipal Building.

WHEREAS pursuant to The Municipal Act, Chapter 396(1)(a) a municipality may pass by-laws for improving buildings required by the corporation;

AND WHEREAS The Rural Municipality of Morris deems it advisable that offices be constructed in the lower level of the Municipal Building;

AND WHEREAS tenders have been submitted to the municipality in connection with the construction of these offices;


AND WHEREAS it is deemed advisable that an architect be retained to supervise the construction of said offices;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED, and it is hereby enacted a s By-Law No. 971 of The Rural Municipality of Morris in council duly assembled as follows:

1. THAT the Rural Municipality of Morris undertake the construction of offices in the lower level of the Municipal Building.
2. THAT the Rural Municipality of Morris enter into a contract with WM. DYCK & SONS LTD., NIVERVILLE, Man. for the construction of these offices in the amount of \$22,784.00, said contract being attached to this By-Law as Schedule "A".
3. THAT the Rural Municipality of Morris retain the services of Hans Peter Langes, Winnipeg, Man., in connection with the architectural supervision of said offices.
4. THAT the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer be and are hereby authorized to do all things necessary to give force and effect to this by-law.
