

BYLAW NO. 979

Being a Bylaw of the Rural Municipality of Morris to provide for the transfer and sale of certain lands formerly the property of the School District of Lone Star # 1629.

WHEREAS the School District of Lone Star No. 1629 has been dissolved by an arbitrator's award made at the Village of Sperling, in the Province of Manitoba, on the 3rd day of May, A.D. 1956;

AND WHEREAS the land described as follows:

The most Southerly Two Hundred and Sixty Four (264) Feet in depth of the most Northerly Nine Hundred and Four (904) Feet in depth of the most Westerly Three Hundred and Thirty (330) Feet in width of the North West Quarter of Section Eighteen (18), in Township Six (6), and Range One (1), West of the Principal Meridian, in Manitoba

was transferred into and became part of the Consolidated School District of Sperling No. 1488 by the terms of the said arbitrator's award;

AND WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Morris is entitled to be the owner of the said land;

AND WHEREAS the said land was advertised for sale by public tender and the best offer of purchase received for the said land was the sum of Thirty Five (\$35.00) Dollars offered by Edward Harry Lewis, of the Post Office of Sperling, in Manitoba, Farmer;

BE IT ENACTED that the land described as follows:

The most Southerly Two Hundred and Sixty Four (264) Feet in depth of the most Northerly Nine Hundred and Four (904) Feet in depth of the most Westerly Three Hundred and Thirty (330) Feet in width of the North West Quarter of Section Eighteen (18), in Township Six (6), and Range One (1), West of the Principal Meridian, in Manitoba.

be transferred to Edward Harry Lewis, of the Post Office of Sperling, in Manitoba, Farmer, at and for the price of Thirty Five (\$35.00) Dollars.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the Reeve and Secretary Treasurer of the said Municipality be authorized to sign all documents on behalf of the Municipality necessary to complete the transfer of land.
