

BY-LAW NO. 980

Being a By-law of the Rural Municipality of Morris relative to the purchase of certain property for the purpose of a nuisance ground.

WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Morris deems it advisable to purchase the following described land:

"Being the most ~~Southerly~~ ^{NORTHERLY} Six hundred and twenty-two and one-half (622.5) feet in depth of the most Easterly Two hundred and seven and one-half (207.5) feet in width of the South East Quarter of Section Six (6) in the Fifth (5) Township and First (1) Range West of the Principal Meridian in Manitoba, excepting thereout firstly: the most Northerly Two hundred and seven and one-half (207.5) feet in depth thereof and secondly: all mines, minerals and other matters together with the right to enter and remove the same",

for the purpose of a nuisance ground;

AND WHEREAS the registered owner of the above described land has offered to sell same to the Rural Municipality of Morris at and for the sum of (\$600.00) Six hundred dollars;

AND WHEREAS the consideration is deemed fair and reasonable;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted, and it is hereby enacted, as By-law No. 980 of the Rural Municipality of Morris, in council duly assembled, as follows:

1. THAT the Rural Municipality of Morris purchase the following described land:

"Being the most ~~Southerly~~ ^{NORTHERLY} Six hundred and twenty-two and one-half (622.5) feet in depth of the most Easterly Two hundred and seven and one-half (207.5) feet in width of the South East Quarter of Section Six (6) in the Fifth (5) Township and First (1) Range West of the Principal Meridian in Manitoba, excepting thereout firstly: the most Northerly Two hundred and seven and one-half (207.5) feet in depth thereof, and secondly: all mines, minerals and other matters together with the right to enter and remove the same"

from Julius Wiens, of the Post Office of Lowe Farm, in Manitoba, Farmer, at and for the sum of Six hundred dollars (\$600.00).

2. THAT the said land be used for the purpose of a nuisance ground.

3. THAT the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer be and are hereby Authorized to do all things necessary to give force and effect to this By-law.
