BY-LAW No. 98²

WHEREAS, Sec. 1183 of The Municipal Act provides for the cancellation of Taxes or any debts owing the municipality;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris considers it in the best interests of the municipality to cancel the hereinafter mentioned taxes and accounts receivable;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris in regular session assembled, enacts as follows:
