

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

BY-LAW No. 987

being a By-Law for the purpose of approving Manitoba Centennial Projects in the Rural Municipality of Morris and apportioning the centennial grant monies to these projects.

WHEREAS, in order that the historic significance of the One-hundredth Anniversary of Manitoba's entry into Confederation should be observed and commemorated in an appropriate manner, the Government of Manitoba has agreed to promote interest in, to plan, to implement programs and to encourage municipalities to carry out local Centennial Projects of a lasting nature that will be enjoyed by all persons in as large a number of areas of the Province as possible;

AND WHEREAS assistance under this Program is provided by the Manitoba Centennial Corporation for an approved project in the amount of One Dollar (\$1.00) per capita, based on the 1966 census. (3,716 population).

AND WHEREAS the following rural projects were submitted to the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris for participation in the Manitoba Centennial Grants program:-

1. Community Park (Rosenort Chamber of Commerce).
2. Community Outdoor Skating Rink
(Lowe Farm Chamber of Commerce)

AND WHEREAS Council is of the opinion that these projects will stand as a worthy memorial to Manitoba's 100th birthday;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris in special session assembled, enacts as follows:-


THAT it recommends to the Manitoba Centennial Corporation for approval, the following projects:-

1. Community Park - Rosenort
2. Community Outdoor Skating Rink - Lowe Farm


AND THAT the grant made available by the Manitoba Centennial Corporation be allocated as follows:-
