

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

BY-LAW No. 994

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 515(1)(a) of The Municipal Act, any Municipality may pass by-laws for constructing, opening, making, improving, deepening, contracting, widening, altering, diverting, straightening, discontinuing or stopping any drain or natural water course within the jurisdiction of the municipality, or providing outlets therefor or preventing surface water flooding into or within the municipality and for entering upon, breaking up, acquiring, taking or using any land in or adjacent to the municipality in any way necessary or desirable, in the opinion of the Council, for any such purpose;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 396(1)(a) of The Municipal Act, whereby any Municipal Corporation may pass by-laws for acquiring such real property as is required for the use of the corporation....;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to improve the "Lewis", "Brown" and so-called "River Lot Drain" in the municipality of Morris;


AND WHEREAS the owners of the lands across whose lands said drains will be improved, have agreed to accept a consideration of \$135.00 per acre for right-of-way required;

AND WHEREAS the consideration is deemed fair and reasonable;


NOW THEREFORE, The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. THAT the Municipality of Morris improve the "Lewis", "Brown" and so-called "River Lot Drain" in the municipality of Morris;
2. THAT the Municipality of Morris pay to the registered owners of the above described lands, the sum of \$135.00 per acre for all the land used as right-of-way in improving said drains.
3. THAT the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer be and are hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to complete the improvement of said drains.

DONE AND PASSED by Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris, assembled at Morris, in the Province of Manitoba, this 12th day of December, A.D. 1969.
