

BY-LAW NO. 996

Being a By-law of the Rural Municipality of Morris
authorizing the assignment of Tax Sale Certificate
No. 75 of the 1968 Tax Sale

WHEREAS at the sale of the land for taxes held on the
13th day of December, A.D. 1968 the Rural Municipality of Morris
purchased at the said Tax Sale, Certificate No. 75 for the sum of
One Hundred Fifty-six and Eighteen one-hundredths (\$156.18) Dollars
covering the following land:

"Part South West Quarter of Section Six in the
Fifth Township and Second Range West of the
Principal Meridian in Manitoba as described
in Certificate of Title No. 78963":

AND WHEREAS the said Tax Sale was assigned to Peter
Harder of the Post Office of Kane in the Province of Manitoba
who paid to the Municipality the said sum of One Hundred Fifty-
six and Eighteen one-hundredths (\$156.18) Dollars together
with penalties thereon:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED and it is hereby enacted
as By-Law No. 996 of The Rural Municipality of Morris as follows:

1. THAT the said Tax Sale Certificate be assigned to the
said Peter Harder of the Post Office of Kane, in the Province of
Manitoba under the seal of the Municipality and the Reeve and
Secretary-Treasurer sign the necessary assignment.

of Manitoba this 18 day of February, A.D. 1970.
