

BY-LAW NO. 777

Being a By-law of the Rural Municipality of Morris for opening a highway, pursuant to Section 474 of The Municipal Act.

WHEREAS Section 474 of The Municipal Act provides, in part, as follows:

- (1) Every municipal corporation may pass by-laws
 - (a) for opening, establishing, making, preserving, maintaining, improving, constructing, repairing, widening, enlarging, altering, diverting, or closing highways within its jurisdiction, and for entering upon, breaking up, taking, or using, any land in any way necessary or convenient for the purposes, subject to the restrictions in this Act, and for preventing and removing any obstruction upon any such highways;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that a highway be opened over, upon and across the lands hereinafter described;

AND WHEREAS the owners of all the land required to be taken for the purposes of establishing and opening the said highway have consented in writing ~~of~~ to the passage of this by-law and to the acquisition of the said land by the Municipality;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY PASSED AND ENACTED as a by-law of the Rural Municipality of Morris, in council duly assembled, as follows:

1. THAT a highway be and is hereby opened and established over, upon and across the lands described as follows:


"All that portion of the North East Quarter of Section Twenty in the Fifth Township and First Range East of the Principal Meridian in Manitoba, required for Riverside Drive as the same is shewn outlined in pink on a Plan prepared by Joseph Henry Wilson of the City of Winnipeg, Manitoba Land Surveyor and sworn to by him on the 13th day of November, 1968;"

and the said lands are hereby dedicated to the public for that purpose;


2. THAT the said plan of survey is hereby adopted and approved, and the Secretary-Treasurer is authorized and directed to endorse the aforementioned ~~map~~ plan of survey for identification,

placing thereon his signature, under the corporate seal of the Municipality, together with a reference to this by-law.
