The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members of Council present. It was by G.Cretton and seconded by M.A.Caron that the minutes of Sept. 12th council meeting be adopted as read.

Correspondence: The conservation officer of the Dept. of resources wondered if we had any beaver complaints this past summer and if so whether we would like the beaver removed in the winter months. - No complaints at this time.

Reed Shaw Stenhouse informed that the insurance coverage under the Group Plan was confirmed and effective as of Sept. 22nd. A further review of coverages will be made in the near future.

Manitoba Water Services Board reported that an engineering report outlining the cost of services re sewer and water facilities for the Village of Rosenort will be completed in the next 2 or 3 months.

Manitoba Good Roads Association announced the 66th Anniversary Dinner and Presentation of Prizes will be held Fri. November 7th at the Fort Garry Hotel

Water Resources Branch reported re its survey of the Blackhurst Drain. Partial information at this time recommended addition of culverts at N 31-6-1E, NE 31-6-1E, N 32-6-1E, NE 32-6-1E N 33-6-1E and in 33-6-1E. Further the drain has a thick growth of bulrushes etc. These should be cleaned out to speed flows.

10 a.m. Court of Revision: 14 written complaints were heard by the court and after due deliberation, most appeals were granted in whole or in part. H.A.Lumgair of the Assessment Branch attended the Court.

A.K.Fast-Alvin Rempel: Resolved that we install one 42" culvert East of 14-5-1E. (NOT carried. 2 in favor; 4 against.

Ben Wiebe-Alvin Rempel: That members of Council be authorized to attend the Union of Manitoba Municipalities Convention on Nov. 25, 26, 27 at Brandon and the expense allowance per representative be set at \$35.00 a day, with the municipality paying the hotel accommodations.

M.A.Caron-A.K.Fast: That we authorize the purchase of the following Standard Culverts from Armco Canada Ltd.:

6 lengths of 30" - 12' and 10 couplers.

1 length of 30" - 14'

12 lengths of 18" - 12' and 6 couplers.

1 length of 36" - 12' and 1 length of 16" and 1 coupler.

12 couplers for 24" culverts.


The accounts as examined by the Finance Committee in the amount of \$35,973.89 were paid.


