

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held a special meeting on Wednesday, August 9, 1995 at 9:00 A.M. in the Council Chambers of the R. M. of Morris.

Reeve Dan Thiessen presided.

Councillors present were George St. Hilaire, Dick Zacharias, Glenn Curdt, Allan Dickson, Bill Martens, Harold Dyck.

The purpose of this special meeting was to review and consider matters pertaining to the ward boundaries for the R. M. of Morris. The Municipal Board has rejected the Municipal Ward Boundary By-law and Council has obtained a legal opinion of the Municipal Board's decision, the interpretation of comments made and options available to Council. The legal interpretation was received from Mr. Charles Chappell of the firm of Aikins, MacAulay and Thorvaldson.

At the start of the meeting, Council held a lengthy discussion on the contents of the letter from Mr. Charles Chappell and course of action should be taken given the information contained in his letter to Council.


Consultant
