Delegation	Mr. Levi Brandt then met with Council to inform Council on the matter of our dispute of billing fees from Mr. C. Chappell. Mr. Brandt indicated that he needs a letter to the Law Society stating his appointment as our representative in this case and also one to the Municipal Board. He will soon be contacting the Municipal Board to gain further information relative to this case. This situation could result in the former Municipal Council being subpoenaed to give comments on the Chappell billing. He wants some direction from Council as to whether he should proceed further or not. He will soon be in contact with the former Council on this matter and consider their responses to the situation. Council's view of the situation was that we should continue to proceed with this case with the Law Society.
