Ms Pat Rempel and Rosalie Fulford attended the meeting at 10:00 a.m. They were representing the Morris and Area Food Bank. They gave council an update on a recent event. They have decided to move the food bank to a new location, and they had understood that the owner of this location would approach the RM and the Town of Morris. Their rent on this location is \$480.00 plus GST per month. The information that they had presented to council before, indicating that 60% of clients were from the RM of Morris was wrong. In 2008, 22.47% of the users came from the RM of Morris. This was based on the number of families. Based on the number of individuals the total for the RM of Morris was 60%. The share of the rent that would be based on RM usage would be \$1,303.26 per year. The Town share would be 54.72%, Emerson would be 10.09%, Montcalm would be 8.14%, DeSalaberry would be 2.93%, and RM of Franklin would be 1.62%. These are all 2008 numbers based on families, which change month to month. The Board members are Pat Rempel, Kim Toews, Helen Klassen, Sally Lewis, Elsie Kohut, Shannon Edel, Marie Rosche, and Liz Giesbrecht.

Councillor Neumann requested that the budget meeting be changed from March 5 to March 6, 2009. Council was in agreement with this change.
